Does the disability affect the student's ability to acquire or demonstrate adaptive behavior skills? The American Association on Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (AAIDD) defines adaptive behavior as the collection of conceptual, social and practical skills that individuals need to function in their daily lives (Schalock et al., 2010). What Is The Example Of Adaptive Behavior?

This study compared the adaptive behavior of 114 learning disabled (LD) subjects with that of large, nationally representative normative samples of normal intelligence and mentally retarded children and youth. The adaptive behavior mean scores of the LD sample were found to be lower than mean scores obtained by the normal intelligence group, and higher than mean scores obtained by the mentally retarded group.
