The key differential diagnosis is between pseudoclaudication due to spinal stenosis and vascular claudication. Pedal pulse examination is helpful but certainly not definitive. Difficulties in differential diagnosis of COPD and asthma in primary care Most patients can be classified as having COPD or asthma by primary care physicians. The use of the two questionnaires did not provide a better differential diagnostic compared with symptoms and spirometry with a BDT. Misdiagnosis may lead to inadequate treatment.

With the combined use of four methods this study found a substantial non-concordance in the diagnosis in patients attending primary care. From a clinical point of view, the differential diagnosis between the two diseases is important, as the therapeutic approach is different.
