Epidemiology. Respiratory complications are the most important source of secondary morbidity and mortality in the neurocritical care unit. Approximately 10% of stroke patients develop respiratory failure requiring intubation and mechanical ventilation (Grotta et al., 1995, Gujjar et al., 1998), translating to approximately 80 000 patients annually in the USA (Mozaffarian et al., 2016).
