Intake. During the intake stroke, the piston moves downward, drawing a fresh charge of vaporized fuel/air mixture. The illustrated engine features a poppet intake valve which is drawn open by the vacuum produced by the intake stroke. Some early engines worked this way; however, most modern engines incorporate an extra cam/lifter arrangement as seen on the exhaust valve.

Working of thermosyphon cooling system in IC engine

What is Scavenging in IC Engine? The process of removing or cleaning out burnt gases by blowing the fresh air or charge in the engine cylinder is known as scavenging. In this process, a mixture of air and fuel or pure air is admitted into the engine cylinder during exhaust at a pressure slightly above at pressure to remove the burnt gases from the cylinder for two-stroke engines.

The principle of working of both SI and CI engines are almost the same except the process of the fuel combustion. In SI engines, the burning of fuel occurs by a spark generated by the spark plug. In CI engines the burning of the fuel occurs due to compression of the fuel to excessively high pressures which does not require any spark.
